

### Michigan's URC Congressional District Fact Sheet

In 2023, members of Michigan's University Research Corridor (University of Michigan, Michigan State University, and Wayne State University) employed 24,900 people on federally funded research grants.

- 4,333, or 17.4% were faculty members
- 10,577, or 42.5% were students






### Michigan's URC Federal Research-Related Spending 2023
