

Michigan's URC State Legislative Fact Sheet

In 2023, members of Michigan's University Research Corridor (University of Michigan, Michigan State University, and Wayne State University) employed 24,900 people on federally funded research grants.

- 4,333, or 17.4% were faculty members
- 10,577, or 42.5% were students

 In the past four years, Michigan's URC purchased research-related goods and services from vendors in 38 of 38 state senate districts, and 110 of 110 state house districts.







Spending on Research-Related Goods and Services from Sponsored Projects at URC Universities , by State Senate District, FY 2023




Spending on Research-Related Goods and Services from Sponsored Projects at URC Universities , by State Senate District, FY 2020-2023
