In 2024, Research Universities for Michigan (RU4M) employed 26,028 people on federally funded research grants.

- 4,394, or 16.9% were faculty members
- 11,918, or 45.8% were students

 In the past five years, Research Universities for Michigan (RU4M) purchased research-related goods and services from vendors in 13 of 13 congressional districts.







