

Research Universities for Michigan (RU4M) State Legislative Fact Sheet

In 2024, Research Universities for Michigan (RU4M) employed 26,028 people on federally funded research grants.

- 4,394, or 16.9% were faculty members
- 11,918, or 45.8% were students





Spending on Research-Related Goods and Services from Sponsored Projects at Research Universities for Michigan (RU4M), by State Senate District, FY 2024




